## Cub World Arrival & Collection Details

### On Arrival – Leaders

The address for the camp is:


*Oxford Wet n Wild, Drayton Rd, Berinsfield, Wallingford OX10 7PQ*


Follow the signs off the A4074 Oxford Road towards Wet'n'Wild. Don't turn left into Berinsfield Village but continue along Burcot Lane which is indicated on the map below and follow the road around to the entrance shown.

On Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July for setting up Tents Leaders may use the access to the Water sports Centre adjacent to the camping area.

From Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July a one-way system, clearly signposted, will be operating on the site as shown on the maps below. The only entrance will be via the entrance shown on the map. This will be clearly identified by flags and signs as the entrance of the camp. All adults staying for the weekend will need a parking permit for their vehicle and should follow the dotted line, on the map below, to the parking area.

 A one-way route for traffic for Parents dropping off and collecting from the site


 Access to Leaders Car Parking, for permit holders only

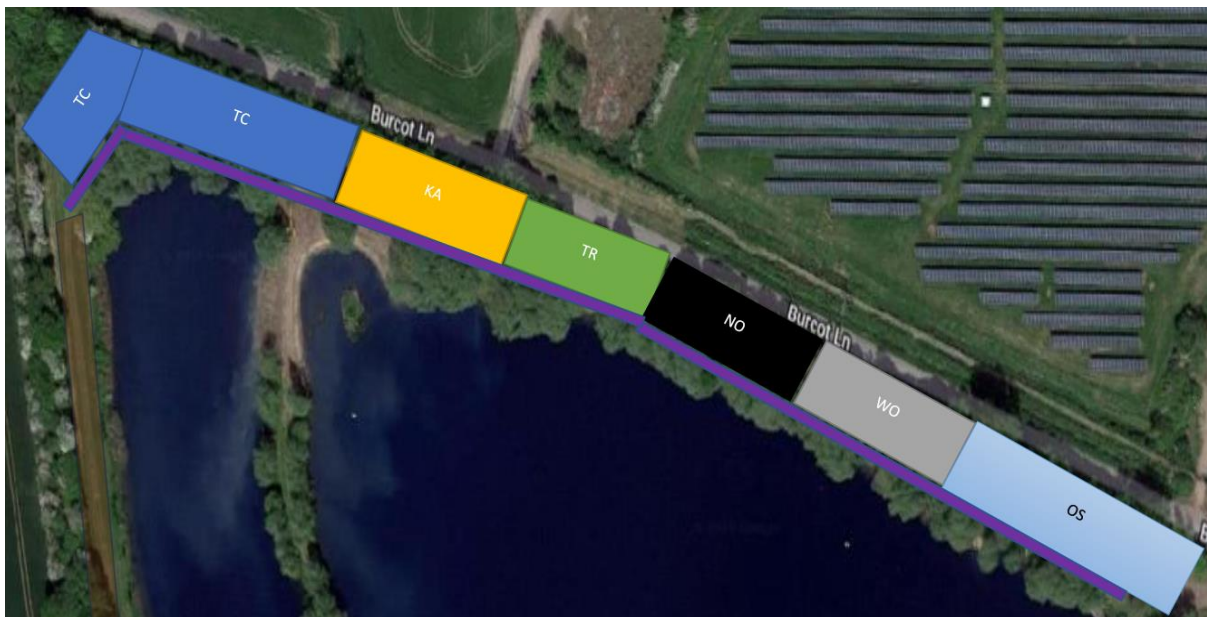






### Prior to the Camp

Leaders can drive & park near their tents in the camping area until 16.00 on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July. All vehicles will need to be removed to the parking area by this time. The camping area will be marked out as indicated below for respective Districts:



The purple line adjacent to the lake represents the route for emergency vehicle access. Please do not park vehicles or pitch tents in this location at any time.

If arriving to pitch tents at any time prior to the camp, please make sure that you refer to your District Rep BEFORE pitching your tents. There will be a plan where each Pack will need to be located within your District camping area, DO NOT pitch your tents where you choose as, if incorrect, you may be asked to move them.

If young people are assisting with the pitching of tents prior to the camp, please make sure that they remain in the camping area and are not allowed to wander around the lakes. Please also be aware that there may be vehicles in the camping area at this time.

If you wish to leave a trailer in the camping area, please check with your District Rep whether there is space for you to do so.



### Arrival and Collection of Cubs at the Camp

As usual on a camp Cubs should arrive and depart the campsite in Uniform. Due to the available space at the venue there is no facility for Parents, who are not camping, to stay with their children. The rectangular red box indicated on the map is an area for “drop-off” only. One or more leaders will need to be positioned here to take Cubs to your camping area. Cubs will need to carry their kit; clothes, sleeping bags, sleeping mats etc from the drop-off area to the camping area, on arrival. Alternatively, kit may be left on the camp site if the tents are set up by leaders before the camp commences.

The Blue Parking zone noted on the map is only for those staying on the site and camping. Parents dropping off cubs are not permitted to park here, and the area is out-of-bounds for Cub Scouts.

The above route for parents, will also be in place for the Sunday afternoon at the end of the camp.
